

Leaf Floor Cleaning Sheet — FAQs

Technical questions and answers for customers

What is a Leaf sheet?

A solid, ultra-concentrated floor cleaner compressed into a thin sheet. Each sheet contains a full dose of cleaner, enough for a mop bucket, bound in a water-soluble carrier that dissolves fully in tap water.

Will it clean as well as bottled floor cleaner?

Yes. Each sheet contains the same quantity of active cleaner as a conventional dose; only the format differs. The cleaner is compressed rather than pre-diluted in a bottle.

What is the correct dosage?

1 sheet per mop bucket (5L of tap water). For floor cleaning machines, dose at the same rate per litre following the manufacturer's instructions.

How is it used?

Fill a mop bucket with tap water, add 1 sheet and stir with the mop head until fully dissolved. Mop as normal and leave to air dry. No rinsing required.

Does the water need to be a certain temperature?

No. Sheets dissolve fully from 20 °C up to 90 °C. Cold tap water works.

Will it leave residue?

No. When dosed correctly the sheet dissolves completely, leaving no residue.

What is the sheet carrier made of? Is it plastic?

The binding agent is a low percentage of polyvinyl alcohol (PVA), a water-soluble synthetic polymer that fully dissolves in water. The sheets are free from microplastics.

Which floors can it be used on?

All sealed hard floors. If in doubt, test on a small, less visible area first.

What are the sustainability benefits?

100% plastic-free packaging; no microplastics; up to 16× lighter than traditional formats, reducing CO₂ from transport and storage; no water shipped; you add it at the point of use.

How should sheets be stored, and what is the shelf life?

Store in a cool, dry location in the sealed original packaging, away from moisture. Shelf life: 2 years from date of manufacture.
