

Leaf Non-Bio Laundry Detergent Sheet — FAQs

Technical questions and answers for customers

What is a Leaf sheet?

A solid, ultra-concentrated laundry detergent compressed into a thin sheet. Each sheet contains a full dose of non-biological detergent — the same quantity as a serving of liquid, powder or a pod — bound in a water-soluble carrier that dissolves fully in the wash.

Will it clean as well as liquid, powder or pods?

Yes. Each sheet contains the same quantity of detergent as a conventional serving; only the format differs. The detergent is compressed rather than diluted or encapsulated.

What is the correct dosage?

1 sheet per standard machine load — 1 sheet = 1 wash, with no measuring or pouring required. For hand washing, which is usually one or two items, half a sheet is fine.

How is it used?

Machine wash: place the sheet at the bottom of the drum, load laundry and run any cycle. Hand wash: dissolve the sheet in water, wash, then rinse thoroughly with clean water.

Does the water need to be a certain temperature?

No. Sheets dissolve fully from 20 °C up to 90 °C, making low-temperature, energy-saving cycles fully effective.

Will it leave residue on clothes or in the machine?

No. When dosed correctly the sheet dissolves completely, leaving no residue — unlike pod membranes, which can leave residues at low temperatures.

What is the sheet carrier made of? Is it plastic?

The binding agent is a low percentage of polyvinyl alcohol (PVA), a water-soluble synthetic polymer that fully dissolves in the wash. The sheets are free from microplastics.

Is the non-bio formula suitable for sensitive skin?

The non-bio formulation contains no enzymes, which helps prevent irritation on sensitive skin and protects delicate materials in the wash.

Is Leaf scented?

Yes — the non-bio sheet carries a subtle perfume. Fragrance is stronger in the box due to the large number of sheets. Post wash, fragrance is mild and pleasant.

What are the sustainability benefits?

100% plastic-free packaging; no microplastics; up to 16× lighter than powder, liquid and pods, reducing CO₂ from transport and storage; effective at 20 °C, cutting wash energy use.

How should sheets be stored, and what is the shelf life?

Store in a cool, dry location in the sealed original packaging, away from moisture. Shelf life: 2 years from date of manufacture.
