

Leaf Dish Washing Sheet — Usage Guide

Dish washing by dishwasher

1 sheet = 1 cycle

One sheet per use, placed in the machine amongst the dishes. Dissolves fully from 20 °C.

AT A GLANCE



1 Dry hands, take a sheet

Remove one sheet with dry hands. Reseal the pack.



2 Scrape first

Scrape food residue into the bin.



3 Load the dishwasher

Load as normal, keeping the spray arms free to rotate.



4 Add 1 sheet

Place the sheet in the machine amongst the dishes.



5 Select any programme

Eco and low-temperature cycles included — dissolves from 20 °C.



6 Run and unload

No extra detergent needed; no residue when dosed correctly.

LOADING & DOSING

- 1

Scrape food residue from items into the bin — no pre-rinse is required.
- 2

Load the dishwasher as normal, ensuring spray arms can rotate freely.
- 3

With dry hands, place 1 sheet in the machine amongst the dishes¹. 1 sheet per use². Reseal the pack immediately to protect remaining sheets from moisture.

WASH CYCLE

- 4

Select any standard programme, including eco and low-temperature cycles — the sheet dissolves fully from 20 °C. Use an intensive programme for heavily soiled loads.
- 5

Run the cycle. No additional detergent is required. Rinse aid and salt may still be used as normal per your machine and water hardness.
- 6

Unload once the cycle finishes — no residue is left on items when dosed correctly.

DISPOSAL & STORAGE

- 7

Recycle the cardboard packaging once empty. There is no chemical container to dispose of.
- 8

Store remaining sheets in the tightly closed original packaging in a cool, dry location, protected from sunlight and out of reach of children.

Handle with dry hands — moisture will begin dissolving the sheet. Avoid contact with eyes; wash hands after prolonged contact. Refer to the SDS for full handling guidance.
- 2

Using more sheets than needed generates unnecessary waste and may lead to greater than expected foaming; this should be avoided.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
