

Leaf Non-Bio Laundry Detergent Sheet — Usage Guide

Laundry: machine wash and hand wash

1 sheet = 1 wash Standard machine load or hand-wash bowl. Dissolves fully from 20 °C to 90 °C.

AT A GLANCE



1 Dry hands, take a sheet
Remove one sheet with dry hands. Reseal the pack.



2 Sheet in the drum
Place the sheet flat at the bottom of the empty drum — not the drawer.



3 Load laundry
Load on top of the sheet. Don't overload — leave a hand's width of space.



4 Select any cycle
20–90 °C, per garment care labels. No extra detergent needed.



5 Run the wash
The sheet dissolves fully as water enters — no residue.



6 Done
Dry as per care labels. Store the pack sealed, cool and dry.

PREPARATION

- 1 Ensure hands are clean and fully dry before handling sheets — moisture will begin dissolving the sheet¹.
- 2 Remove the required number of sheets from the pack and reseal the packaging immediately to protect remaining sheets from moisture. 1 sheet = 1 wash².

APPLICATION — MACHINE WASH

- 3 Place the sheet flat at the bottom of the empty drum. Do not place the sheet in the detergent drawer.
- 4 Load the laundry on top of the sheet. Do not overload the drum — leave a hand's width of space at the top for effective circulation.
- 5 Select the cycle appropriate to the fabrics, following garment care labels. The sheet dissolves fully at any wash temperature from 20 °C to 90 °C³
- 6 Run the wash. No rinse aid or additional detergent is required.

APPLICATION — HAND WASH

- 7 Fill a bowl or basin with water at 20 °C or above. Add 1 sheet and agitate gently until fully dissolved.
- 8 Add the garments and wash by hand. Stubborn soiling may require longer soaking or repeated agitation.
- 9 Rinse thoroughly with clean water until no suds remain, then dry as per garment care labels.

DISPOSAL & STORAGE

- 10 Dispose of used hand-wash solution down a sink or drain. There is no chemical container to dispose of.
- 11 Recycle the cardboard packaging once empty.
- 12 Store remaining sheets in the tightly closed original packaging in a cool, dry location, protected from sunlight and out of reach of children.

- 1 Avoid contact with skin and eyes; wash hands after handling (SDS P264). Refer to SDS v1.0 (15/02/2023) for full handling guidance.
- 2 Using more sheets than needed generates unnecessary waste and may lead to greater than expected foaming; this should be avoided.
- 3 For mixed or delicate loads, follow the lowest temperature indicated on garment care labels. The non-bio formulation is suitable for delicates and sensitive skin.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Leaf sheets are a laundry detergent and are designed for washing textiles only. Do not use for surface cleaning or dishwashing — dedicated Leaf sheet products exist for those applications.
