

Leaf Toilet Cleaning Sheet — Usage Guide

Toilet cleaning

1 sheet = 1 bottle Drop into a trigger spray bottle with 750ml of water. Dissolves fully from 20 °C.

AT A GLANCE



1 Dry hands, take a sheet
Remove one sheet with dry hands.
Reseal the pack.



2 Make up the bottle
Drop the sheet into a spray bottle,
fill with water and shake.



3 Flush first
Flush to remove loose debris; flush
again if soiling remains.



4 Spray bowl and rim
Spray under the rim and around the
internal sides of the bowl.



5 Brush
Brush the rim, sides and below the
waterline, including the U-bend.



6 Flush and inspect
Flush; repeat for stubborn stains.
Wash hands.

PREPARATION	
1	Wash hands, and in workplace settings put on gloves ¹ .
2	Ensure hands are dry, remove one sheet from the pack and reseal the packaging immediately ² .
3	Drop the sheet into a trigger spray bottle, fill with 750ml of water, attach the spray head and shake until fully dissolved.

APPLICATION	
4	Flush the toilet to remove loose debris; if loose soiling remains in the standing water, flush again.
5	Spray the cleaning solution liberally under the rim and around the internal sides of the bowl.
6	Brush thoroughly under the toilet rim.
7	Brush the internal sides of the bowl above the waterline, working from top to bottom.
8	Spray again at regular intervals where soiling persists.
9	Brush all accessible surfaces below the waterline, including the first part of the U-bend.
10	Flush the toilet and inspect; repeat the brushing steps for any stubborn staining ³ .
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DISPOSAL & STORAGE	
11	In workplace settings, dispose of single-use PPE in the relevant waste stream and wash hands.
12	Recycle the cardboard packaging once empty.
13	Store remaining sheets in the tightly closed original packaging in a cool, dry location, protected from sunlight and out of reach of children.

- 1 In workplace settings, wear gloves in accordance with local policy and your COSHH assessment. In domestic use, handle with dry hands and wash hands after handling.
- 2 Keep the toilet brush dedicated to toilet cleaning; inspect before use and replace when soiled or damaged.
- 3 Stubborn soiling may require repeated passes, heavier agitation or longer contact time with the solution.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
