

Leaf Multi-Purpose Cleaning Sheet — Usage Guide

Hard surface cleaning: spray bottle or bucket

1 sheet = 1 bottle 750ml of water, in a spray bottle or bucket. Dissolves fully from 20 °C.

AT A GLANCE



1 Dry hands, take a sheet
Remove one sheet with dry hands. Reseal the pack.



2 Roll into the bottle
Roll the sheet and insert through the bottle neck.



3 Fill and shake
Fill with water, attach the spray head and shake until dissolved.



4 Spray and wipe
Spray the surface and wipe top-to-bottom in overlapping 'S' passes.



5 Rinse the cloth
Rinse the cloth regularly; replace it when visibly soiled.



6 Air dry
Leave the surface to air dry. Refill the bottle with a fresh sheet when empty.

PREPARATION

- 1 Ensure hands are clean and fully dry before handling sheets — moisture will begin dissolving the sheet¹.
- 2 Remove the required number of sheets from the pack and reseal the packaging immediately to protect remaining sheets from moisture.
- 3 Spray bottle: fill with 750ml of water, roll one sheet and insert it through the neck. Attach the spray head tightly and shake until fully dissolved. Note the preparation date on the bottle²
- 4 Bucket or open container: drop 1 sheet in first, then add 750ml of water per sheet and stir until dissolved.

APPLICATION

- 5 Remove loose debris from the surface.
- 6 Spray the surface directly, or dampen a cloth from the container and wring out excess³
- 7 Clean vertical surfaces first, wiping top to bottom in an overlapping 'S' pattern; wipe flat surfaces from the cleanest area to the dirtiest, edges first.
- 8 Stubborn soiling may require repeated passes, heavier agitation or longer contact time with the solution.
- 9 Rinse the cloth regularly during use; replace it when it shows visible soiling after rinsing.
- 10 Leave the surface to air dry.

DISPOSAL & STORAGE

- 11 Dispose of used bucket solution down a sink or drain.
- 12 Recycle the cardboard packaging once empty.
- 13 Store remaining sheets in the tightly closed original packaging in a cool, dry location, protected from sunlight and out of reach of children.

- 1 In workplace settings, wear gloves in accordance with local policy and your COSHH assessment. In domestic use, handle with dry hands and wash hands after handling.
- 2 Using more sheets than needed generates unnecessary waste and may lead to greater than expected foaming; this should be avoided.
- 3 Leaf can be used across a wide range of surfaces, but if in doubt, always test on a small, less visible area first.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Leaf multi-purpose sheets are designed for routine cleaning of hard surfaces. They are a cleaner, not a disinfectant. Do not use on surfaces that may be damaged by water.
